1. No sale of sacred herbs and pipes.
2. No alcohol or drugs.
3. God Provides Food Bank is not responsible for any lost, stolen merchandise, or damage of any kind.
4. Vendors must bring their own generators and electrical cords. All generators must be on plywood and not on grass.
5. Set up time will be on Friday after 12:00 noon, or Saturday morning.
6. All vehicles must be off the grounds by 9:00pm and parked in your designated parking area.
7. No walk-ins or one day set up.
8. You will be responsible for your own children.
9. No dumping of waste and garbage on ground, please keep you're camping & booth space clean
10. There will be security during the day and night.
11. There is no refund of fees under any circumstances
12. Each vendor will be asked to donate an item value of at least \$25 or more for the raffle, and collected by a committee member on Saturday morning.
13. As a vendor you are asked to keep your booth open during operation hours.
14. Hand made Native American items only. (Please keep in, mind the act of 1990) sale of imports, toys, bomb farts, fart spray, caps, and poppers will not be tolerated.
15. Arts and crafts booth will not be allowed to sell food or beverage of any kind.
